OnPoint to celebrate new facility

OnPoint, formerly known as Allegan County Community Mental Health Services, will host a ribbon-cutting and open house on Monday April 17, 2023 at 3:00 pm to celebrate the completion of construction at its new headquarters at 540 Jenner Drive, Allegan. The event is open to the public.

The agency, which has provided behavioral health services for Allegan County since 1970, will relocate and reopen at the new location on Monday, May 8, 2023. Funding for the project was provided through a \$5.635 million loan

from the rural development arm of the US Department of Agriculture (USDA) and a \$2.5 million grant from the Michigan Legislature through the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC).

Mark Witte, OnPoint's Executive Director, said "In 2021, we obtained a federal grant to establish a Certified Community Behavioral Healthcare Clinic for community-wide services for Allegan residents. In 2022, we rebranded as OnPoint to signify our commitment to excellence and promote stigma-free access to behavioral health and homelessness services. Building on that progress, we are relocating to the City of Allegan so the entire community can obtain these important services in an attractive and easily accessible facility."
