NOMs Data Collection

National Outcome Measures (NOMs)

To comply with the Government Performance Results and Modernization Act (GPRA) of 2010, SAMHSA requires CCBHC grantees to collect National Outcome Measures (NOMs) client-level data at intake, at a six-month follow-up, and at program discharge. Starting in FY2023, SAMHSA revised its requirements to reduce the administrative burden of NOMs collection and to capture data more representative of the broader CCBHC population. NOMs data collection is now required for a random sample of OnPoint's CCBHC clients. Through the CCBHC-IA program, we aim to collect NOMs data on 390 individuals over the four-year grant period: 210 individuals in grant year one and 60 individuals annually in years two through four. This report tracks progress toward the cumulative goal.

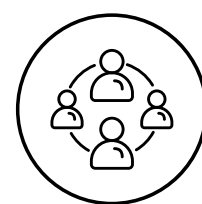

NOMS Outcomes



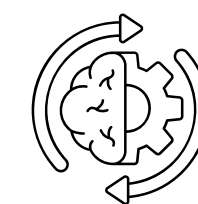
Improved Mental Health Symptoms

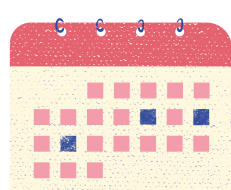

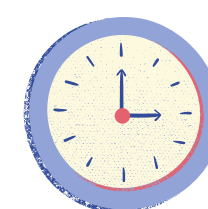
