Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)

What is MAT?

MAT uses FDA-approved medications—like Suboxone (buprenorphine), and Vivitrol (naltrexone) to:

- Reduce cravings and withdrawal symptoms
- Support long-term recovery
- Improve physical and mental well-being
- Lower the risk of overdose and relapse

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) is a proven, effective approach for treating substance use disorders, combining medications with counseling and peer support to help you regain control of your life.
